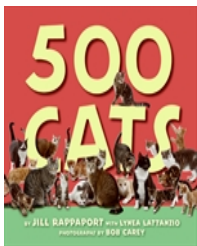

## CHRISTMAS PET TIPS

If you are having a holiday party, close your pet into a quiet room with a favorite toy where it will not be stressed by all the strange sights and sounds. Guests may not be as careful when coming and going as you are. Having a pet run away at Christmas time is a sure way to invite the Grinch for the holidays.

If possible, put your Christmas tree in a room that your pet does not have access to. If this is not possible, follow the guidelines below.

Do not use tinsel or foil garland if you have a young kitten in the house, or if your cat likes to eat everything it finds. Just as string and thread pose dangers to your pet, tinsel can tear up your pet's intestine if ingested.

Make sure your pet cannot get to the water under your live Christmas tree. The sap from the tree, and the additives frequently added to the water to preserve the tree can make your pet ill.

Securely anchor your Christmas tree. Your pet may try to climb up the tree, toppling your work of art in the process. Consider putting an eye bolt in the ceiling and tying the tree to it.

You may want to use unbreakable ornaments during the rambunctious first 2 years of a cat's life. The glitter of dangling glass ornaments is irresistible to a kitten.

Be prepared to find ornaments on the floor when you get home. Your kitten will bat them and play with them, despite your best efforts. It will try to climb up the tree.

## MY TWO CENTS by Pat Miranda

Jack Perez is a director/producer/script writer from the Los Angeles area. He surrendered a cat to us about four years ago and was so impressed with the facility, and being the caring and generous animal loving person that he is, promised to come back when he had time to help us promote our sanctuary. A year ago last spring, he finally did just that. Jack came to the shelter and spent the whole day filming the cats, the facility and Lynea. Back to LA he went to edit and bring into existence the video that's on YouTube now. It's just shy of five minutes long, but the impact it has had is incredible and overwhelming. We have people from all over the world viewing this video. The response was immediate. Emails came pouring in and hits to our website went through the roof.

At about the same time, we met Ivor Durham, a fellow cat rescuer from the bay area. Because his rescue operation doesn't have a shelter, just foster homes, when they get ferals or unadoptable cats and kittens, they quickly run out of space for new arrivals. Wanting these cats to live a normal, free life, he found us and surrendered a truckload of kitties.

Noticing that our website was out of date, Ivor, and his partner in rescue, Christina Peck, offered to create a new and improved site for us, free of charge. Of course we accepted. Christina designed and organized it and Ivor orchestrated all the technical stuff that makes it work.

And the rest is history. Jack's YouTube video got people interested and curious about The Cat House which led them to the website and Ivor's creation gave them a venue for seeing for themselves what we are all about.

Thanks to the brilliance and compassion of these two men, The Cat House is finally on the map - globally! We now have new steady supporters from all over the world and donations are coming in. Because of the interactive website, we can accept donations, surrender and sponsor payments through Paypal, our Sponsor- A-Cat program has gone from 6 or 7 new sponsors a year to 250 new ones in just 1 ½ years, and the adoption and surrender processes have been streamlined.

All of these changes have enabled us to pay off some old debt, make some much-needed improvements and expand our facility, allowing us to save more lives.

I must admit it has created a heap more work. For the office staff... tons more email to answer (Lynea has had to learn how to email and answer her own), more donations to log in, phone calls up the wazoo, our mailing list has gone from a little over 2,000 to over 7,300, which creates more newsletters to print and more data input. We have had to add to the crew in the office. And the website...it's a living growing entity. With each new feature we add, someone suggests another, or Tammy, Carmen, Lynea, Karla or myself want to add or change something, which Ivor graciously does without ever complaining about what pests and pains in the bum we have become. And I'm proud to say I have my very own personal Mujibar tech support dude (Ivor's alter ego).

And the poor shelter staff ...more cats to take care of, more mouths to feed and water, poop to scoop, kennels to clean, with the new kitten quarantine, we are able to take in additional babies, but that means more medicating, more vaccinations and more poop, so we've had to add more shelter staff, too. The list goes on and on, but I wouldn't change a thing. The world has finally taken notice of The Cat House on the Kings!!

I think I am going to love it here.

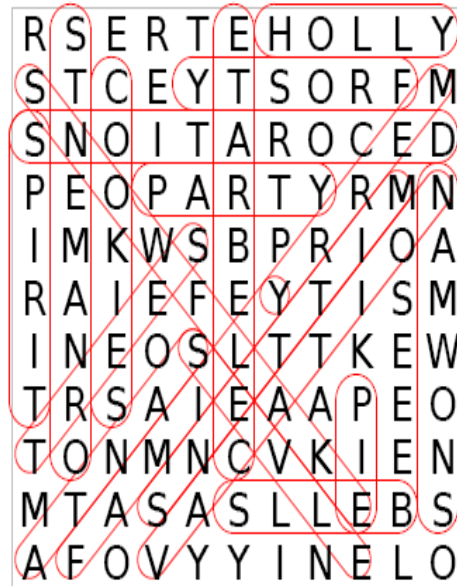

## CRYSTAL CAT WATCH RAFFLE


